A LAW TO AUTHORISE THE USE OF HER MAJESTY'S FORCES
IN THE PERFORMANCE OF POLICE DUTIES.

54 of 1955

[28th October, 1955.]

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as Her Majesty's Forces (Performance of Police Duties) Law.

Governor may direct Her Majesty's Forces to perform police duties.

2. The Governor may direct that members of Her Majesty's Forces shall have power to carry out and perform duties which members of the Cyprus Police Force are authorised by the law in force for the time being to carry out and perform, and in the carrying out and performance of any such duties, members of Her Majesty's Forces shall have all the powers, privileges and protection conferred upon a member of the Cyprus Police Force under the provisions of the law in force for the time being.

Amendment, etc., of direction under section 2.

3. The Governor may amend, vary or revoke any direction, given under section 2, by a subsequent direction.
