ORDINANCE 24 OF 1963.

AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND THE ADVOCATES ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Advocates (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963 and shall be read as one with the Advocates Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

2. The principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after Section 6 thereof the following new Section to be numbered 6A:-

"Appearance
of Republican
pupils in Court.

6A.—(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 6 of this Ordinance any person registered as a pupil under the provisions of the Republican Advocates Law:-

(a) may appear for or on behalf of the Republican advocate in whose office he

is reading or the Attorney General of the Republic as the case may be and on his instructions-

- (i) before the Judge's Court in any civil proceedings, for the purpose of making an ex-parte application or of mention or for the purpose of an adjournment or of obtaining judgment by default:

Provided that a pupil shall not be entitled to declare a settlement;

- (ii) before the Judge's Court in any criminal proceedings, for the purpose of entering a plea of not guilty, or for the purpose of entering a plea of guilty and pleading thereon where the offence is punishable with imprisonment not exceeding six months or a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds or both, or for the purpose of an adjournment;

- (b) may appear before the Judge's Court with the advocate in whose office he is reading or if he is reading in the office of the Attorney-General of the Republic, with a Republican law officer, and in his presence take such part in the proceedings before the Judge's Court as the advocate or the Republican law officer may permit him to do.

(2) The client for whom the pupil is appearing under this section shall not be charged with any additional fees for any such appearance but the advocate on whose behalf or with whom the pupil is appearing may pay to the pupil such remuneration as the advocate may consider reasonable.

(3) No pupil shall be allowed to appear before the Judge's Court under this section unless he is qualified to appear in a court of the Republic under the provisions of the Republican Advocates Law."
