ORDINANCE 4 OF 1970.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE
(DUTIES AND DRAWBACKS) ORDINANCE, 1968.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows :

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Duties and Drawbacks) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1970 and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise (Duties and Drawbacks) Ordinance, 1968 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"), and shall come into operation on the seventh day of May, 1970.

Short title and commencement.

Ordinances 2, 12 and 15 of 1968, 5 and 13 of 1969.

2. Section 8 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the full stop at the end thereof, substituting a colon and inserting immediately thereafter the following proviso :

Section 8 of the principal Ordinance amended.

"Provided that whenever in the said Third Schedule any alternative rates of duties appear against any class or description of goods the higher or highest of the rates applicable shall be charged, levied or collected."

3. The Second Schedule to the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the particulars of each of the tariff headings therein specified under the number appearing in the first column of Appendix I to this Ordinance the particulars shown against each such tariff heading in the second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth column of the said Appendix.

4. The Third Schedule to the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the particulars of item 6 thereof the particulars set out in the first and second columns of Appendix II to this Ordinance.

ORDINANCE 5 OF 1970.

AN ORDINANCE

TO MAKE PROVISION FOR CARRYING INTO EFFECT
WITHIN THE SOVEREIGN BASE AREAS OF AKROTIRI
AND DHEKELIA THE SURRENDER OF FUGITIVE
CRIMINALS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE
EXTRADITION ACTS 1870 TO 1932.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows :-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Extradition Ordinance, 1970.

Short title.

2. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpretation.

“Acts” means the Extradition Acts 1870 to 1932 of the United Kingdom ;

Vict C. 52.

“Senior Judge’s Court” or “Judge’s Court” means the Senior Judge’s Court or Judge’s Court as described in the Courts Ordinance 1960, or any member thereof, as the case may be, having jurisdiction.

3. All powers vested in and acts authorised or required to be done by a Police Magistrate or any Justice of the Peace in relation to the surrender of fugitive criminals in the United Kingdom under the Acts, are hereby vested in, and may in the Sovereign Base Areas be exercised and done by, the Judge’s Court, in relation to the surrender of fugitive criminals under the Acts.

4. When a fugitive criminal is brought before the Judge's Court, Section 9 of the Extradition Act 1870, in its application to the Sovereign Base Areas, shall have effect as if the first paragraph of the Section provided that the Court shall hear the case in such manner, and shall have such jurisdiction and powers, including power to remand in custody or on bail, as the Administrator may by Order prescribe.

5. Section 10 of the Extradition Act 1870, in its application to the Sovereign Base Areas, shall have effect as if the words "be sufficient to warrant trial" were substituted for the words "justify the committal for trial" appearing in the fifth line of the first paragraph thereof.

6. The Senior Judge's Court may exercise the power under the provisions of section 12 of the Extradition Act 1870, of discharging a criminal when not conveyed within two months out of the Sovereign Base Areas.

Operation of
the Ordinance.

7. This Ordinance shall not come into operation until Her Majesty shall by Order in Council direct that the said Ordinance shall have effect within the Sovereign Base Areas as if it were part of the Extradition Act 1870, and it shall thereafter come into operation on the day on which such Order in Council is published in the Gazette of the Sovereign Base Areas.
