ORDINANCE 6 OF 1975.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE WATER SUPPLY (SPECIAL MEASURES) ORDINANCE 1964.

ACTING ADMINISTRATOR

BE it enacted by the Acting Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Water Supply (Special Measures) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1975 and shall be read as one with the Water Supply (Special Measures) Ordinance, 1964 as amended by the Water Supply (Special Measures) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1965 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

Short title.

Ordinances 14/64 and 8/65.

- 2. Section 4 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended—
- (i) by inserting immediately after paragraph (a) of subsection (1) thereof the following new paragraph to be lettered (aa):—
 - "(aa) pump, abstract, utilize or exploit underground water save under the provisions of this Ordinance; or";
- (ii) by inserting immediately after paragraph (e) of subsection (1) thereof the following new paragraph:—

"For the purposes of this subsection it shall be presumed that any act or action, in respect of which a permit under the provisions of this section is required, was done or taken by the owner of the Section 4 of the principal Ordinance amended. plot of land on which such act or action has taken place, unless it is proved that such act or action was done or taken without his knowledge.";

- (iii) by substituting for the words "twenty-five pounds" in the fifth line of sub-section (2) thereof the words "one hundred pounds".
- Section 5 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the words "twenty-five pounds" in the sixth line of sub-section (6) thereof the words "one hundred pounds".

Section 9 of the principal Ordinance amended. 4. Section 9 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the words "twenty-five pounds" in the fourth line of sub-section (3) thereof the words "one hundred pounds".
