ORDINANCE 4 OF 1980.

AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the Surcharge (Imported Goods) (Temporary Provisions) Ordinance, 1977.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Surcharge (Imported Goods) (Temporary Provisions) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1980 and shall be read as one with the Surcharge (Imported Goods) (Temporary Provisions) Ordinance, 1977 as amended by the Surcharge (Imported Goods) (Temporary Provisions) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1978 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

Short title.

Ordinances 7/77 and 13/78.

2. The principal Ordinance is hereby amended by repealing Section 3 thereof and substituting therefor the following new Section:—

Section 3 of the principal Ordinance repealed and replaced.

"Imposition of surcharge.

3. There shall be levied and collected, in accordance with Customs legislation, a surcharge of five per centum (5%) on the dutiable value of any imported goods cleared for consumption in the Island of Cyprus, as prescribed in Customs legislation."
