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**AGRICULTURAL LAND CONSOLIDATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 2011**

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An Ordinance to amend the Agricultural Land Consolidation (Amending and Consolidating)  
Ordinance 1999

**BE** it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

**1. Short title**

This Ordinance may be cited as the Agricultural Land Consolidation (Amendment) Ordinance 2011.

**2. Meaning of “principal Ordinance”**

In this Ordinance, “principal Ordinance” means the Agricultural Land Consolidation (Amending and Consolidating) Ordinance 1999(a).

**3. Section 13 (valuation committee) amended**

Section 13(1) of the principal Ordinance is amended by omitting “whose term of office shall be for a period of two years”.

**4. Transitional provision**

- (1) This section applies to a person who was elected under section 13(2) of the principal Ordinance no more than 2 years before the day on which this Ordinance comes into force.
- (2) The amendment made by section 3 is deemed to have been in force at the date of the election of every person to whom this section applies.

**5. Commencement**

This Ordinance comes into force on the day after it is published in the Gazette.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

### **(This note does not form part of the Ordinance)**

1. This explanatory note relates to the Agricultural Land Consolidation (Amendment) Ordinance 2011 (the “Ordinance”). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Ordinance. It does not form part of the Ordinance.
2. The note should be read in conjunction with the Ordinance. It is not, and is not meant to be, a comprehensive description of the Ordinance. So when a section or part of a section does not seem to require any explanation or comment, none is given.
3. Section 3 of the Ordinance amends section 13 of the Agricultural Land Consolidation (Amending and Consolidating) Ordinance 1999 (the “principal Ordinance”). In future, members of a valuation committee elected by entitled owners will not be elected for a fixed term of 2 years.
4. Section 4 of the Ordinance provides that members of valuation committees and runners-up elected under section 13(2) of the principal Ordinance within the last 2 years are not subject to the 2-year term for which they were originally elected.
