
PRISONS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 2011

An Ordinance to amend the Prisons Ordinance 1971.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. Short title and commencement

This Ordinance may be cited as the Prisons (Amendment) Ordinance 2011 and comes into force on 6 October 2011.

2. Section 11 of the Prisons Ordinance 1971 amended

Section 11 (Regulations for the administration and discipline of the Prison Service) of the Prisons Ordinance 1971(a) is amended by inserting after subsection (3) the following new subsection—

- “(4) Regulations made under subsection (1) in relation to pensions for prison officers may be made so as to have effect as from a date before the regulations were made.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
