
**INTERPRETATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE
2014**

An Ordinance to amend the Interpretation Ordinance 2012

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Interpretation (Amendment) Ordinance 2014.

Commencement

2. This Ordinance comes into force on 1 July 2014.

Interpretation Ordinance 2012 amended

3. The Interpretation Ordinance 2012(a) is amended in accordance with section 4.

Schedule 1 amended (definitions)

4. Schedule 1 is amended by repealing the definition of “Police officer” and substituting the following definition—

““Police officer” or “peace officer” means an officer of the Police Service (and includes the Chief Constable and the Deputy Chief Constable).”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Ordinance)

1. This explanatory note relates to the Interpretation (Amendment) Ordinance 2014 (the “Ordinance”). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney-General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Ordinance.
2. The Ordinance amends the Interpretation Ordinance 2012 to make it clear that, unless the contrary intention appears, where the term “peace officer” is used in legislation, it means an officer of the Sovereign Base Areas Police Service.
