An Ordinance to amend the Exercise of Functions Ordinance 2012

Be it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Exercise of Functions (Amendment) Ordinance 2015.

Commencement

2. This Ordinance comes into force on 23 February 2015.

- (2) After paragraph 8 in Schedule 1, insert—
 - "9. Senior Registrar(b).
 - 10. Registrar(c).".

- 2. The Ordinance amends the Exercise of Functions Ordinance 2012 by adding the Senior Registrar and the Registrar of the courts of the Sovereign Base Areas to the list of office-holders who may delegate functions to other public officers.
