**PROTECTION OF PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19)
(AMENDMENT) (NO.2) ORDINANCE 2022**

An Ordinance to amend the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) Ordinance 2022

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) (Amendment) (No.2) Ordinance 2022.

(2) This Ordinance comes into force on 22 April 2022.

Amendment of the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) Ordinance 2022

2.—(1) The Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) Ordinance 2022(a) is amended as follows.

(2) Omit section 10 (places of residence).

(3) In section 12 (events including weddings and christenings)—

(a) Ordinance 04/2022, as amended by Ordinance 08/2022.

- (a) in subsection (1) omit “(b) the maximum number of people seated at a table does not exceed 12,”;
 - (b) in subsection (2) omit “(c) the maximum number of people seated at a table does not exceed 12.”.
- (4) In section 18 (catering premises)—
- (a) at the end of paragraph (a), add “and”,
 - (b) in paragraph (b), for “, and”, substitute “.”,
 - (c) omit paragraph (1)(c).
- (5) In section 19 (nightclubs, reception halls, discos, music and dance venues etc)—
- (a) at the end of paragraph (a), add “and”,
 - (b) in paragraph (b), for “, and”, substitute “.”,
 - (c) omit paragraph (1)(c).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Ordinance)

1. This explanatory note relates to the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) (Amendment) (No.2) Ordinance 2022 (the “Ordinance”). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Ordinance. It does not form part of the Order. It is not intended to be a comprehensive description.

2. Section 2 amends the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) Ordinance 2022. Subsection (2) removes the restriction on the number of people permitted to be simultaneously present at a place of residence. Subsections (3) to (5) remove the restriction on the number of people permitted to be seated at a single table at events, catering premises, nightclubs and similar venues.
