PROTECTION OF PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19) (AMENDMENT)(NO.9) ORDINANCE 2022

An Ordinance to amend the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) Ordinance 2022

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

Short title and commencement

- **1.**—(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) (Amendment) (No.9) Ordinance 2022.
 - (2) This Ordinance comes into force on 23 September 2022.

Amendment of the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) Ordinance 2022

- **2.**—(1) The Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) Ordinance 2022(**a**) is amended as follows.
- (2) In section 2 (interpretation) omit the definitions of "booster dose", "catering premises", "dependent" and "place of residence".
 - (3) Omit section 9 (mass events and gatherings).

- (4) In section 34 (community councils and municipality councils), in subsection (15) for the second occurrence of "(13)" substitute "(14)".
 - (5) Omit section 37 (power to give instructions to doctors, surgeons and nurses).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Ordinance)

- **1.** This explanatory note relates to the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) (Amendment) (No.9) Ordinance 2022 ("the Ordinance"). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Ordinance. It does not form part of the Ordinance.
- **2.** This note should be read in conjunction with the Ordinance. It is not meant to be a comprehensive description of the Ordinance.
- **3.** Section 2 of the Ordinance amends the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) Ordinance 2022 to reflect amendments to the Republic legislation relating to COVID-19. In particular, it removes a general prohibition on certain events and gatherings.
