BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

Short title and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) (Amendment) (No.10) Ordinance 2022.
 - (2) This Ordinance comes into force on 18 November 2022.

Amendment of the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) Ordinance 2022

2.—(1) The Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) Ordinance 2022(**a**) is amended by omitting section 26 (rent relief for businesses affected by the prohibition of their activities).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

- 1. This explanatory note relates to the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) (Amendment) (No.10) Ordinance 2022 ("the Ordinance"). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Ordinance. It does not form part of the Ordinance.
- **2.** This note should be read in conjunction with the Ordinance. It is not meant to be a comprehensive description of the Ordinance.
- **3.** Section 2 of the Ordinance amends the Protection of Public Health (COVID-19) Ordinance 2022 to reflect amendments to the Republic legislation relating to COVID-19. Specifically, it removes rent relief for businesses that were prohibited from operating in January and February 2021.
