# FIXED PENALTY (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 2023

An Ordinance to amend the Fixed Penalty Ordinance 2010

**BE** it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.**—(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Fixed Penalty (Amendment) Ordinance 2023.

(2) This Ordinance comes into force on 24 May 2023.
