INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 1 - Laws of Cyprus).

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY UNDER SECTION 22.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 22 of the Interpretation Ordinance, the Administrator has been pleased to depute the Chief Officer to exercise the powers set out in the second column of the schedule hereto, which are conferred upon the Administrator under the provisions of the Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) Ordinance, 1960, set out in the first column of the said schedule.

SCHEDULE

Provisions of Ordinance 5 of 1960.	Description of Powers.
Section 18(4)(a)	Power to cause the name of any person to be added to the recognised residents list.
Section 18(4)(b)	Power to delete the name of any person from the recognised residents list.
Section 18(4)(b)	Power to give notice to a person of the intention of the Administrator to delete his name from the recognised residents list.
Section 18(4)(b)	Power to take into consideration any representations made by a person to whom notice has been given of an intention to delete his name from the recognised residents list.
Section 18(6)	Power to designate a place in which, and to fix times when the recognised residents list or copies thereof shall be available for inspection.
Section 19(1)(a)	Power to grant a certificate of recognised residence.
Section 19(1)(b)	Power to serve notice upon a person to whom a certificate of recognised residence has been granted, that such certificate has been cancelled.
Section 19(1)(c)	Power to restore a certificate of recognised residence.
Proviso to Section 19(2)	Power to give notice to a person of the intention of the Administrator to cancel a recognised resident's certificate.
Proviso to Section 19(2)	Power to take into consideration any representations made by a person to whom notice has been given of an intention to cancel his recognised resident's certificate.
