THE COMMODITIES AND SERVICES (REGULATION
AND CONTROL) ORDINANCE

(Ordinances 11 of 1962, 9 of 1963 and 3 of 1967).

CONTROL AND FIXING OF PROFIT
ORDER MADE UNDER SECTIONS 3(1) AND 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sub-section (1) of Section 3 and Section 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Perishable Goods) (Control and Fixing of Profit) Order, 1967.

2. In this Order—

“perishable goods” means the goods specified in the Schedule to this Order;

“purchase price” means the wholesale price of perishable goods charged by a producer or wholesaler to a retailer.

3. Perishable goods are hereby declared to be controlled commodities for the purposes of the Ordinance.

4. The maximum percentage profit which may be derived from the sale by retail of each of the items of perishable goods specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order, shall not exceed the respective percentages set out in the second column of this said Schedule, opposite each of the said items, which shall be calculated on the purchase price of such items.

THE CORONERS ORDINANCE (TEMPORARY
SUSPENSION OF PROVISIONS) ORDINANCE, 1965,
Ordinance No. 5 of 1965.

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3 of the Coroners Ordinance (Temporary Suspension of Provisions) Ordinance, 1965 the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:—

THE LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 226 - Laws of Cyprus -
and Ordinances 12 of 1963
and 9 of 1964).

NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 and 5.

Whereas it has been represented to the Administrator that it is desirable to improve the domestic water supply of Episkopi village (a village which lies partly within the Sovereign Base Areas and partly within the Republic of Cyprus) by means of obtaining additional water from a borehole which lies within the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area;

And whereas, furthermore, it is, in the opinion of the Administrator, in the public interest to assist and collaborate with the appropriate authorities of the Republic of Cyprus in conserving and improving water supplies in the Island of Cyprus;

And whereas, therefore, it is, in the opinion of the Administrator, desirable for public purposes to improve the domestic water supply of Episkopi village, as aforesaid, and therefore the cost thereof is to be borne by the Sovereign Base Areas Administration:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, the Administrator does hereby declare the improvement of the water supply of Episkopi village to be an undertaking of public utility and does hereby entrust the acquisition of the land required for the said undertaking to the Chief Officer, Sovereign Base Areas.

THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS PROTECTION
ORDINANCE

(Cap. 65 - Laws of Cyprus - and Ordinances
19 of 1961, 17 of 1962, 19 of 1964 and 6 of 1966).

GAME RESERVE AREA ORDER.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 19 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Ordinance, the Administrator hereby declares the area specified in the Schedule hereto to be a Game Reserve.

SCHEDULE

All that area of land and Limassol Salt Lake marshes comprised within the following boundaries:

On the north the boundary runs in a straight line from Forest Cairn I across the Salt Lake to Triangulation point 16 Khtista on the sea-shore; thence in a southerly direction along the sea-shore as far as the Royal Air Force Station boundary; thence in a westerly direction along the perimeter fencing of the Royal Air Force Station Akrotiri and thence in a north-westerly direction along the Fassouri-Akrotiri road up to the starting point, all which area is more particularly shown on a map marked Limassol Salt Lake Game Reserve and kept at Headquarters Sovereign Base Areas Administration.
