**THE POWERS AND DUTIES (OFFICERS
OF THE REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS) ORDINANCE**

(Ordinances 2 of 1960, 3 of 1961 and 19 of 1966).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Administrator by Section 3 of the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) Ordinance, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Acting Administrator hereby makes the following Order :

1. This Order may be cited as the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1973 and shall be read as one with the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) Order as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

THE ADOPTION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 274—Laws of Cyprus).

APPOINTMENT AND REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT OF
WELFARE OFFICER UNDER SUB-SECTION (1)
OF SECTION 20.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Administrator by subsection (1) of section 20 of the Adoption Ordinance, the Acting Administrator has appointed Miss Betty C. Cooling of the Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Families Association to be Welfare Officer and to perform the functions provided by the aforesaid Ordinance in respect of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia.

2. The appointment as a Welfare Officer of Miss B. Driscoll, made by Public Instrument No. 73 of 1971, is hereby revoked.

THE COURTS ORDINANCE

RULES OF COURT MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR
UNDER SECTION 63.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Administrator by Section 63 of the Courts Ordinance, 1960 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Acting Administrator hereby makes the following Rules of Court :—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Civil Procedure (Amendment) Rules, 1973 and shall be read as one with the Civil Procedure Rules as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules").

2. Rule 1 of Order 8 of the principal Rules is hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) by deleting the abbreviation and figure "£ 50" in the first line of paragraph (i) thereof and substituting therefor the abbreviation and figure "£ 100";
- (b) by deleting the abbreviation and figure "£ 2" in the second line of paragraph (ii) thereof and substituting therefor the abbreviation and figure "£ 5".

3. The heading and Rule 1 of Order 65 of the principal Rules are hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) by deleting the abbreviation and figure "£ 50" in the heading thereof and substituting therefor the abbreviation and figure "£ 100";
- (b) by deleting the word "fifty" in the second line of Rule 1 thereof and substituting therefor the word "hundred".

THE GUARDIANSHIP OF INFANTS AND
PRODIGALS ORDINANCE

(Cap. 277 — Laws of Cyprus).

GUARDIANSHIP OF INFANTS AND PRODIGALS
(AMENDMENT) RULES.

RULES OF COURT MADE UNDER SECTION 25.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 25 of the Guardianship of Infants and Prodigals Ordinance, the Administrator, with the advice and assistance of the Senior Judge, hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Guardianship of Infants and Prodigals (Amendment) Rules, 1973 and shall be read as one with the Guardianship of Infants and Prodigals Rules (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”).

2. The principal Rules are hereby amended by inserting, immediately after Rule 5, the following new Rules to be numbered 5A, 5B, 5C, 5D and 5E respectively:—

“5A—(1) Subject to the provisions of Rule 4, whenever an application is made to the Judge’s Court under the Ordinance for the issue of an order relating to the person of an infant who resides in the Areas, the Judge’s Court shall appoint a Welfare Officer whose duty shall be to investigate as fully as possible all the circumstances relating to the proposed order for the purpose of safeguarding the interests of the infant before the Judge’s Court and to submit the relevant report to the Judge’s Court and, specifically, it shall be the duty of the Welfare Officer to—

- (a) carry out an investigation relating to all matters alleged in the application or related to it and which, in his opinion, will assist the Judge’s Court to decide about the fitness of the applicant to be appointed as guardian of the infant and submit a report thereof to the Judge’s Court;
- (b) carry out interviews personally or through another Welfare Officer acting on his behalf for this purpose, of any person applying for the issue of an order or who is referred to in the application or of a person to whom service of the notice of the application is required under Rule 6 (3) of these Rules;
- (c) satisfy himself whether the infant is of such an age or not as to understand the consequences of the order applied for and, if satisfied that the infant is of such an age —
 - (i) to find out whether the infant has been informed about the application and the said consequences and, if he has not been so informed, to inform him thereof;

- (ii) to inform the Judge's Court that the infant has been informed accordingly ;
- (d) present himself before the Judge's Court whenever necessary for the purpose of the application :

Provided that the Judge's Court may, whenever it considers it fit, appoint the Welfare Officer as a judicial guardian.

5B. Every Welfare Officer appointed under these Rules and every Welfare Officer acting on his behalf must treat all information obtained, during his investigation, as confidential and must not disclose any part of it to any other person except so much thereof as would be necessary for the due execution of his duties.

5C. Whenever a Welfare Officer appointed under these Rules is unable to carry out his duties by reason of illness, absence or for other reasons beyond his control, anything required or authorised to be carried out by such Welfare Officer under these Rules may, subject to any other instructions of the Court, be carried out by any other Welfare Officer acting on his behalf.

5D. In the case of an application relating to the person of an infant the Judge's Court shall not issue an order under this Ordinance unless the undermentioned persons are present before it in person :—

- (a) the applicant ;
- (b) the parents (if any) of the infant ;
- (c) if there are no parents, the person with whom the infant resides or under whose care he is.

5E. "Welfare Officer" in these Rules has the same meaning as Section 2 (1) of the Adoption Ordinance."

3. Rule 6 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by deleting the figures "17 (3)" appearing in the seventh line of paragraph (2) thereof and substituting therefor the figures "23 (3)".

4. Rule 10 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by deleting the words "ten shillings" appearing in the second line of paragraph (1) thereof and substituting therefor the words "one pound".
