THE FORESHORE PROTECTION ORDINANCE, 1975

(Ordinance No. 9 of 1975).

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 9 of the Foreshore Protection Ordinance, 1975 the Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Foreshore Protection (Prescription of Forms) Order, 1977.
 2. The permit which may be issued under paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Ordinance shall be in the form set out in the Form I of the First Schedule.
 3. The permit which may be issued under paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Ordinance shall be in the form set out in the Form II of the First Schedule.
 4. The permit which may be issued under paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Ordinance shall be in the form set out in the Form III of the First Schedule.
 5. The permit which may be issued under paragraph (d) of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Ordinance shall be in the form set out in the Form IV of the First Schedule.
 6. The fees payable for the issue of the permits referred to in the preceding paragraphs shall be those set out in the Second Schedule.

PERMIT FOR THE ERECTION OF A HUT, e.t.c.

Permission is hereby granted to of to erect a hut/booth (or other structure) on the foreshore situated —

1. on plot sheet/plan 2. on private land, registration No. plot sheet/plan of the area which is protected under the Foreshore Protection Ordinance, 1975 under the following terms and conditions :

- a) The hut/booth/or other structure shall be erected at a distance of feet from the sea. b) The hut/booth/or other structure shall be of the following dimensions, type and size c) The hut/booth/or other structure shall be provided with the following sanitary conveniences d) The hut/booth/or other structure shall be provided with a sufficient quantity of drinking water in suitable containers to the satisfaction of the Area Officer taking into consideration the requirements of public health e) The following materials shall be used for the erection of the hut/booth/or other structure f) The colour of materials to be used for such erection shall be g) The hut/booth/or other structure shall be used for the following purposes

- h) The hut/booth/or other structure shall be removed on and the said area shall be restored to its original condition.
- i) There shall be no interference with the free passage of pedestrians across the foreshore and the use of the sea opposite the area where the hut/booth/or other structure is to be erected.
- j) The permit is not transferable and it may be revoked at any time without compensation if the said area is required for any purpose of public utility or if the holder thereof has failed to comply with any term or condition inserted in this permit.

- d) The gear and other articles of the boat shall be kept under or inside the boat.

- f) Following a direction by the competent authority, the boat shall be temporarily removed for the purpose of cleaning the sand on the foreshore.

- e) portable dustbins/refuse containers for every tables, chairs or other objects shall be placed.
- f) The objects shall be removed as directed by the competent authority in order to clean the sand on the foreshore and shall always be removed during the night.
- g) On each side of the area used on the foreshore life-belts shall be placed and each of them shall be tied to a rope, the length of which shall be feet.

THE LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 226 — Laws of Cyprus —
and Ordinances 12 of 1963 and 9 of 1964).

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas by Public Instrument No. 31 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette No. 473 of 20th June 1977, the Administrator declared the establishment of a wireless transmitting station east of the Salt Lake to be an undertaking of public utility ;

And whereas the Area Officer Akrotiri, in compliance with subsection (1) of Section 6 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, by Public Instrument No. 32 of 1977, gave particulars of the communal privileges to be acquired in connection with the said undertaking of public utility (hereinafter referred to as "the property") ;

And whereas the Area Officer Akrotiri, in compliance with subsection (2) of the said section, forwarded to the Administrator the required recommendations, plan and particulars ;

And whereas the Administrator has approved the plan and particulars submitted, and has considered it expedient, having regard to the circumstances of the case, that the property be acquired :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 7 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, the Administrator hereby sanctions the acquisition of the property under the provisions of the said Ordinance.

THE AGRICULTURAL INSURANCE (FACILITATION

**THE AGRICULTURAL INSURANCE (FACILITATION
OF REPUBLICAN AGRIGULTURAL INSURANCE SCHEME)
ORDINANCE, 1977**

(Ordinance No. 11 of 1977).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 7 (2).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sub-section (2) of section 7 of the Agricultural Insurance (Facilitation of Republican Agricultural Insurance Scheme) Ordinance 1977, the Chief Officer, in consultation with the Republican Agricultural Insurance Board, hereby directs that the premium payable to the Republican Board by insured persons shall be assessed on a percentage basis in relation to the gross return from each crop as set out below :
