**THE HIRE PURCHASE, CREDIT SALE
AND HIRING OF PROPERTY (CONTROL) ORDINANCE**

(Ordinance No. 13 of 1966).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 3 of the Hire Purchase, Credit Sale and Hiring of Property (Control) Ordinance, 1966 the Administrator hereby orders as follows :

1. This Order may be cited as the Hire Purchase and Credit Sale (Movable Property) (Control) (Amendment) Order, 1979 and shall be read as one with the Hire Purchase and Credit Sale (Movable Property) (Control) Order, 1967 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by deleting the First Schedule thereof and substituting therefor the following new First Schedule.

**CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER
MADE UNDER SECTIONS 3 (1) AND 4 (1).**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sub-section (1) of Sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order—

This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Imported Frozen Lamb) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1979 and shall be read as one with the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Imported Frozen Lamb) Order, 1974 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").
