THE HIRE PURCHASE, CREDIT SALE AND HIRING  
OF PROPERTY (CONTROL) ORDINANCE

(Ordinance No. 13 of 1966).

ORDER UNDER SECTION 3.

---

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Administrator by Section 3 of the Hire Purchase, Credit Sale and Hiring of Property (Control) Ordinance, 1966 the Acting Administrator hereby orders as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Hire Purchase and Credit Sale (Movable Property) (Control) (Amendment) Order, 1986 and shall be read as one with the Hire Purchase and Credit Sale (Movable Property) (Control) Order, 1967 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").
2. The principal Order is hereby amended by deleting the First Schedule thereof and substituting therefor the following First Schedule:

## THE COURTS ORDINANCE

(Ordinances 3 of 1960, 7 of 1961, 19 of 1962, 5 of 1963,  
3 of 1965, 9 of 1977 and 12 of 1984).

RULES OF COURT UNDER SECTION 63.

---

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 63 of the Courts Ordinance, 1960 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Administrator hereby makes the following Rules of the Court:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Civil Procedure (Amendment) Rules, 1986 and shall be read as one with the Civil Procedure Rules, as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”).

2. Order 44 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by inserting immediately after Rule 14 thereof the following new Rule to be numbered 15:—

“15. Where the bailiff is unable to obtain, for any reason, the assistance of the Chairman or member of the Commission of the village in which the execution is to be effected he may, subject to directions received from the Writs Clerk seek the assistance of any appropriate person or public Officer or if he considers it necessary not to ask the assistance of the aforementioned persons but proceed with the execution of the writ alone, he shall himself carry out the duties that the Chairman of the Village Commission or the member of the Village Commission would have exercised if his assistance was obtained.”.

3. The principal Rules are hereby amended by deleting wherever it appears, the word “Mukhtar” and substituting therefor the words “Chairman of the Village Commission”.

## THE POLICE ORDINANCE, 1967

(Ordinances 9 of 1967, 14 of 1969 and 7 of 1975).

ORDER BY THE CHIEF POLICE OFFICER  
UNDER SECTION 23(1)

---

In exercise of the powers vested in me by subsection (1) of Section 23 of the Police Ordinance, 1967, being of the opinion that there is an exceptional case where the public interest so requires, I hereby order that that part of Waterloo road which extends from the Western junction which joins the Larnaca - Famagusta road to the junction of the said Waterloo road which joins the Ormidhia - Dhekelia road, shall be closed to all traffic, other than pedestrian, between the hours of 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. daily from 8th September, 1986.

2. This order shall come into effect on 8th September, 1986.
