RULES OF COURT UNDER SECTION 63.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Administrator by Section 63 of the Courts Ordinance, 1960 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Acting Administrator hereby makes the following Rules :—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Civil Procedure (Amendment) Rules, 1987 and shall be read as one with the Civil Procedure Rules as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”).

2. Order 33 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by inserting immediately after Rule 6 thereof the following new Rule to be numbered 6A :—

“6A. The Court may, if it thinks it expedient in the interests of justice, fix or adjourn a trial for mention upon such terms (if any) as it may think fit.”.

30. For attending the Court with a view to appearance at the hearing — whether the hearing is adjourned for want of time—the minimum fee for appearance may be allowed unless the Court otherwise directs.

31. If the action (or appeal) is settled when it comes on for hearing, the Court may allow fees as for hearing.

32. In proceedings for mandamus or upon originating summonses or other proceedings not provided for above, the Court shall specify the scale to be applied.

33. Subject to any special Order of the Court and the provisions of the basic civil procedure rule in determining the scale applicable in Appendix B the following shall be the criteria :

- (a) From commencement of action down to and including appearance or to obtain judgment in default of appearance—

The claim on the writ of summonses.

- (b) After appearance and down to judgment—

The amount or value actually in dispute between the parties as disclosed upon the pleadings.

(c) In actions for money claims—

The amount awarded by judgment or the amount for which action has been settled.

(d) In other actions—

The value of the subject matter of the action actually in dispute between the parties.

(e) After judgment in respect of proceedings for execution—

The amount for which execution is sought.

(f) In respect of appeals—

The amount or value of the subject matter involved in the appeal.

(g) In respect of maintenance orders—

The monthly amount fixed by the Court.

34. The Court may order that the remuneration of advocate as against his client be based on a different scale other than the scale which would be applicable under paragraph 33 above.

35. In respect of any judgment by consent the remuneration and actual expenses shall be fixed separately from the amount adjudged for the claim.

4. The Civil Procedure (Increase of Advocates' Fees) (Special Provisions) (Amendment) Rules, 1984, are hereby revoked.

**THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1984**

(Ordinances 7 of 1984, 2 of 1987 and 13 of 1987).

**REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR
UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 22.**

In exercise of the powers vested in the Administrator under subsection (1) of Section 22 of the Streets and Buildings Regulation (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1984, the Acting Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Streets and Buildings (Consolidation) (Amendment) Regulations, 1987 and shall be read as one with the Streets and Buildings (Consolidation) Regulations, 1984 as amended by the Streets and Buildings (Consolidation) Regulations, 1985 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. Regulation 6 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) by deleting the full stop at the end of sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (3) thereof and substituting therefor a colon ;
- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following new proviso :—

"Provided further that a building on a plot which resulted from a partition under the provisions of subsection (1A) of Section 27 of the Immovable Property (Tenure, Registration and Valuation) Ordinance, shall abut on the boundary of such plot with the other plot which resulted from such partition."

3. Regulation 17 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by adding at the end of the proviso to paragraph 1 thereof the following :—

"and in addition the erection of industrial buildings or warehouses situated within industrial zones on a plot of land having a right of access of approximately one thousand feet in length and a width of not less than twelve feet if the application in respect of such building has been submitted to the appropriate authority before the coming into operation of these Regulations :".
