## NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas by Public Instrument No. 86 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette No. 831 of the 13th December, 1988 the Administrator declared the establishment of the Communal Park in Akrotiri village to be an undertaking of public utility ;

And whereas the Area Officer Akrotiri, in compliance with subsection (1) of Section 6 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, by Public Instrument No. 1 of 1989 gave particulars of the land required in connection with the said undertaking of public utility (hereinafter referred to as "the property) ;

And whereas the Area Officer Akrotiri, in compliance with subsection (2) of the said section, forwarded to the Administrator the required recommendations, plan and particulars ;

And whereas the Administrator has approved the plan and particulars submitted and has considered it expedient, having regard to the circumstances of the case, that the property be acquired ;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 7 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, the Administrator hereby sanctions the acquisition of the property under the provisions of the said Ordinance.

THE POLICE ORDINANCE, 1967

(Ordinances 9 of 1967, 14 of 1969 and 7 of 1975).

ORDER BY THE CHIEF POLICE OFFICER UNDER SECTION 23(1).

---

In exercise of the powers vested in me under subsection (1) of Section 23 of the Police Ordinance, 1967, I, hereby order that a one-way traffic system shall operate throughout the length of the M 1 road from its junction with the Limassol/Paphos road to its junction with the Akrotiri/Kolossi road. Access shall be permitted to traffic at the Western junction of the M 1 with the Limassol/Paphos road to travel in an Easterly direction. Traffic shall be denied access at the Eastern junction of the M 1 with the Akrotiri/Kolossi road, to take the diversion through Kolossi, Erimi and Episkopi Villages, with effect from the date of publication of this Order in the Gazette and shall remain in force for seven days unless annulled or amended within that period.
