THE LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 226—Laws of Cyprus—and Ordinances 12 of 1963,
9 of 1964, 1 of 1968, 4 of 1987 and 19 of 1988).

NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

Whereas it has been represented to the Administrator that it is desirable to construct a road within the Akhna Forest Refugee Estate, in the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia ;

And whereas it is, in the opinion of the Administrator desirable, for public purposes, to construct the road as aforesaid ;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, the Administrator does hereby declare the construction of the aforesaid road to be an undertaking of public utility and does hereby entrust the acquisition of the land required for the said undertaking to the Chief Officer, Sovereign Base Areas.

THE ADOPTION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 274—Laws of Cyprus).

APPOINTMENT AND REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT OF
WELFARE OFFICERS UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 20.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Section 20 of the Adoption Ordinance, the Administrator has appointed Mrs. Joy Baily and Miss Maggie Spellman of the Soldier's, Sailors' and Airmen's Families association, to be Welfare Officers and perform the functions provided by the aforesaid Ordinance in respect of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia.

2. The appointment of Mrs. Janice Gray as a Welfare Officer made by Public Instrument No. 12 of 1986, is hereby revoked.

**THE AKROTIRI VILLAGE (SPECIAL PROVISIONS)
ORDINANCE, 1966**

(Ordinances 3 of 1966, 9 of 1979, 4 of 1981,
14 of 1985 and 4 of 1989).

**APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL COMMITTEE
UNDER SECTION 4 (9A).**

Whereas I am of the opinion that, upon or before the expiration on the 24th day of March, 1989 of the term of office of the elected members of the Special Committee constituted under the above named Ordinance, succeeding elected members cannot lawfully be elected under the provisions of the Second Schedule to the above named Ordinance, I the Administrator, in exercise of the powers vested in me under the provisions of subsection (9A) of Section 4 of the above named Ordinance, after consultation with the appropriate authorities of the Republic of Cyprus, hereby appoint the persons whose names are shown below to constitute the Special Authority for the administration and control of specified property in Akrotiri village and they shall hold office from 24th March, 1989 to 24th May, 1989.
