THE JUVENILE OFFENDERS ORDINANCE

THE PROTECTION OF HEALTH (CONTROL OF SMOKING)
ORDINANCE

(Ordinances 8 of 1981 and 11 of 1988).

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 9 of the Protection of Health (Control of Smoking) Ordinance, 1981, the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Protection of Health (Control of Smoking) (Amendment) Regulations, 1989 and shall be read as one with the Protection of Health (Control of Smoking) Regulations, 1988 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations.").

P. I. No. 89/88.

2. Regulation 7 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by inserting immediately after paragraph (2) thereof, the following new paragraph to be numbered (2A):—

"(2A) Notwithstanding the provisions contained in paragraphs (1) and (2) of this Regulation, with regard to tobacco products other than cigarettes, the warning sign referred to in paragraph (1) may, where application of the provisions of such paragraph (1) is impossible, be placed on the rear side of the packet, either printed or pasted upon it. In such a case the warning sign shall be inscribed in ink of either red or black colour on a white coloured base with the effect that the ink shall form a contrast to the predominant colour on the rear side of the packet."

These Regulations shall come into effect on the 1st September, 1989.
