THE COURTS ORDINANCE

(Ordinances 3 of 1960, 7 of 1961, 19 of 1962, 5 of 1963,
3 of 1965, 9 of 1977, 12 of 1984 and 6 of 1988).

 RULES OF COURT UNDER SECTION 63.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 63 of the Courts Ordinance, 1960 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Administrator hereby makes the following Rules of Court:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Civil Procedure (Amendment) Rules, 1990 and shall be read as one with the Civil Procedure Rules as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”).

2. Rule 2 of Order 32 is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the full stop thereof, the following:—

“2 (a) Without prejudice to the generality of this Rule, any person who desires the issue of a summons to be served on a salaried public servant of the Crown in any capacity or of the Republic, a Municipality or an Improvement Board of the Areas or the Republic, shall pay into Court, a sum equivalent to the time lost by the witness, having first presented to the Registrar all the necessary details with regard to the official remuneration of the witness.”.

3. Rule 2 (1) of Order 65 is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the full stop thereof, the following:—

“In actions relating to claims in respect of accidents where the sum claimed varies between £1000 - £5000, the plaintiff may opt for the use of either the form provided by this Rule or the one provided by Rule 1 of Order 2.”.

**THE COMMODITIES AND SERVICES (REGULATION
AND CONTROL) ORDINANCE**

(Ordinances 11 of 1962, 9 of 1963, 3 of 1967,
10 of 1972 and 10 of 1982).

CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER
MADE UNDER SECTIONS 3 (1) AND 4 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Pasteurised and/or Homogenised Fresh Cow's Milk) (Amendment) Order, 1990 and shall be read as one with the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Pasteurised and/or Homogenised Fresh Cow's Milk) Order 1975 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by deleting the Schedule thereto and substituting therefor the following new Schedule:—
