THE POLICE ORDINANCE

(Ordinances 9 of 1967, 14 of 1969 and 7 of 1975).

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 23 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Section 23 (1) of the Police Ordinance, I hereby order that Waterloo Road South, from its eastern junction with the Larnaca/Famagusta Road to its junction with the Ormedhia/Dhekelia Road, shall be closed to all vehicular traffic, except for access, from 1700 to 1930 hours on 26th June, 1990. During this period, vehicular traffic will be diverted around Dhekelia Garrison via Larnaca/Famagusta Road and Waterloo Road North.

**THE PETROLEUM (RE-ADJUSTMENT OF RETAIL PRICE)
ORDINANCE, 1986**
(Ordinance 8 of 1986).

REGULATIONS UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him under Section 3 of the Petroleum (Re-adjustment of Retail Price) Ordinance, 1986, the Chief Officer hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Petroleum (Re-adjustment of Retail Price) Regulations, 1990.
2. The retail price at which petroleum may be sold or offered for sale in the Areas shall not exceed the maximum price set out in the Second Column of the Schedule.
3. Public Instrument No. 66 of 1987 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

First Column Description of Petroleum	Second Column Maximum Sale Price
1. Liquefied Petroleum gas	£140 per metric tonne
2. Petrol (extra)	29,4 cents per litre
3. Petrol (regular)	27,2 cents per litre
4. Illuminating oil	9,2 cents per litre
5. Diesel oil	9,2 cents per litre
6. Light Mazut	4,4 cents per litre
7. Heavy Mazut	£25 per metric tonne
8. Asphalt :	
(i) 60/70	£50 per metric tonne
(ii) 80/100	£49 per metric tonne
(iii) S/125	£57 per metric tonne
