THE LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 226—Laws of Cyprus—and Ordinances 12 of 1963,
9 of 1964, 1 of 1986, 4 of 1987 and 19 of 1988).

NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

Whereas it has been represented to the Administrator that it is desirable to lay High Voltage and Fibre Optic Cables between Kolossi CEA Sub-Station and the Akrotiri Salt Lake Aerial Fields in the Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri, the cost whereof is to be borne by the Ministry of Defence in the United Kingdom.

And whereas it is, in the opinion of the Administrator, desirable for military purposes, to lay High Voltage and Fibre Optic Cables as aforesaid;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, the Administrator has been pleased to declare the laying of High Voltage and Fibre Cables to be an undertaking of public utility and has been pleased to authorise the carrying out of the said undertaking and to entrust the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to the Defence Land Agent, Ministry of Defence (Cyprus).
