**THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE**

(Ordinances 7 of 1984, 2 of 1987, 13 of 1987 and 18 of 1988).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 17.

Take Notice that the Area Officer of the Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri as appropriate authority, having satisfied himself that the buildings situated on Plots Nos. 199, 97, 88, 66/1, 73, 117, 111, 110 and 56 of S/Plan 58/47 Vill, Akrotiri village, are in such a condition as to be dangerous to persons residing in the area or passers-by, has decided that steps must be taken to remove such danger either by demolition or repair of the said buildings.

THE LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 226 — Laws of Cyprus — and Ordinances 12 of 1963,
9 of 1964, 1 of 1986, 4 of 1987 and 19 of 1988).

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas by Public Instrument No. 180 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette No. 920 of the 21st December, 1990 the Administrator declared the acquisition of certain land within that part of Kolossi village lying within the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area for the purpose of preserving Kolossi Castle, which is an ancient monument, to be an undertaking of public utility ;

And whereas the Area Officer, Akrotiri, in compliance with subsection (1) of Section 6 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, by Public Instrument No. 15 of 1991 gave particulars of the land required in connection with the said undertaking of public utility (hereinafter referred to as “the property”);

And whereas the Area Officer, Akrotiri, in compliance with subsection (2) of the said Section, forwarded to the Administrator the required recommendations, plan and particulars ;

And whereas the Administrator has approved the plan and particulars submitted and has considered it expedient, having regard to the circumstances of the case, that the property be acquired ;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 7 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, the Administrator hereby sanctions the acquisition of the property under the provisions of the said Ordinance.

**THE INDUSTRIAL TRAINING AUTHORITY
(REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS) (RECOGNITION)
ORDINANCE, 1979.**

(Ordinances 1 of 1979 and 20 of 1980).

**REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER
SECTIONS 9 AND 15.**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Sections 9 and 15 of the Industrial Training Authority (Republic of Cyprus) (Recognition) Ordinance, 1979, the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Industrial Training Authority (Employers' Levy) (Amendment) Regulations, 1991 and shall be read as one with the Industrial Training Authority (Employers' Levy) Regulations, 1979 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the first proviso to paragraph (1) thereof and substituting therefor the following new proviso :—

"Provided that no levy shall be payable in respect of any part of wages exceeding two hundred and fourteen pounds weekly or nine hundred and twenty six pounds monthly."

3. These Regulations shall come into effect on the 1st April, 1991.
