THE COURTS ORDINANCE

(Ordinances 3 of 1960, 7 of 1961, 19 of 1962, 5 of 1963
3 of 1965, 9 of 1977, 12 of 1984 and 6 of 1988).

RULES OF COURT UNDER SECTION 63.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 63 of the Courts Ordinance, 1960 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Administrator hereby makes the following Rules:-

1. These Rules may be cited as the Civil Procedure (Amendment) Rules, 1993 and shall be read as one with the Civil Procedure Rules as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules").

2. Rule 1(2) of Order 10 is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof, immediately after the word "summons", the following:-

"An application for the issue of a third party notice shall be made not later than within a month from the date when the statement of defence was filed. This time limit shall not be extended."

3. Rule 5 of Order 63 is hereby amended by deleting the sentence, "The paper used shall be thirteen inches by eight, or thereabouts" appearing in the third and fourth lines thereof and substituting therefor the following:-

"The paper used shall be of the series of international size paper 210 x 297 millimetres (A4 marking)".

4. (i) Rule 2(a) of Order 32 is hereby amended by deleting the words "public" and "the Crown in any capacity or of the Republic" appearing in the third and fourth lines thereof.

(ii) The following new Rule 32 (2) (b) is herewith inserted immediately thereafter:-

"32 (2) (b). Without prejudice to the generality of this Rule, any person who desires the issue of a summons to be served on a public servant of the Crown in any capacity or of the Republic, shall deposit with the Court the sum of £27 for the time lost by the witness and in a case where the witness does not appear in Court, such sum shall be refunded."

5.- (a) Rule 1 of Order 65 is hereby amended by deleting in the second line thereof, the words "five thousand" and substituting therefor the words "one thousand".

(b) Rule 2 (1) of Order 65 is hereby amended by deleting in toto that part of the Rule commencing, "In actions relating to claims provided by Rule 1 of Order 2."

6. These Rules of Court shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 1st day of January, 1993.

**THE PETROLEUM (RE-ADJUSTMENT OF RETAIL PRICE)
ORDINANCE, 1986**

(Ordinance 8 of 1986 and 18 of 1990).

REGULATIONS UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him under Section 3 of the Petroleum (Re-adjustment of Retail Price) Ordinance, 1986, the Chief Officer hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Petroleum (Re-adjustment of Retail Price) Regulations, 1993.

2. The retail price at which petroleum may be sold or offered for sale in the Areas shall not exceed the maximum price set out in the Second Column of the Schedule hereto.

3. Public Instrument No. 178 of 1990 as amended by P. Is. Nos. 4 of 1991 and 12 of 1992 is hereby revoked.

5. Illuminating oil	10 cents per litre
6. Diesel oil	10 cents per litre
7. Light Mazut	7 cents per litre
8. Asphalt :	
(i) 60/70	£ 71 per metric tonne
(ii) 80/100	£ 70 per metric tonne
(iii) S/125	£ 80 per metric tonne
