**THE PETROLEUM (RE-ADJUSTMENT OF RETAIL PRICE)
ORDINANCE, 1986**

(Ordinances 8 of 1986 and 18 of 1990).

REGULATIONS UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him under Section 3 of the Petroleum (Re-adjustment of Retail Price) Ordinance, 1986, the Chief Officer hereby makes the following Regulations:-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Petroleum (Re-adjustment of Retail Price) Regulations, 1994 and shall be read as one with the Petroleum (Re-adjustment of Retail Price) Regulations, 1986 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").
- 2.(a) The maximum retail prices at which petroleum may be sold or offered for sale in the Areas, as such are shown in the First Schedule to these Regulations, do not include the value added tax provided under the Value Added Tax Ordinance, 1992.
- (b) The maximum retail prices indicated in the Second Schedule to these Regulations are inclusive of the value added tax at the 8% rate which is applicable as from the 1st October, 1993.

1. Liquefied Petroleum gas	£185 per metric tonne
2. Light Mazut	7 cents per litre
3. Asphalt:	
(i) 60/70	£ 71 per metric tonne
(ii) 80/100	£ 70 per metric tonne
(iii) S/125	£ 80 per metric tonne

SECOND SCHEDULE

First Column Description of Petroleum	Second Column Maximum Retail Price
1. Petrol	
(a) Petrol extra	36,7 cents per litre
(b) Petrol unleaded	36,7 cents per litre
(c) Petrol regular (of low lead content)	34,6 cents per litre
2. Illuminating oil	10,8 cents per litre
3. Diesel oil	10,8 cents per litre
