**THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS (PROTECTION
AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974**

(Ordinances 11 of 1974, 1 of 1982, 3 of 1985, 9 of 1988,
20 of 1989, 13 of 1991 and 15 of 1993.)

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance 1974, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue lap-wings, jackdaws, wood-pigeons, rock-pigeons, thrushes, starlings, woodcocks, ducks, snipes, sparrows, crows, magpies and foxes, in the areas set out in the Schedule hereto, during the period commencing on Wednesday 3rd March 1999 and ending on Sunday 14th March 1999 inclusive, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

- (a) shooting shall take place on Sundays and Wednesdays only;
- (b) shooting shall take place between sunrise and sunset only;
- (c) no dogs shall be allowed to accompany the hunters;
- (d) no fires shall be kindled;
- (e) hunters shall keep 200 metres away from main roads;
- (f) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered;
- (g) shot-guns shall be carried to and from the areas specified in this notice, dismantled;
- (h) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun;
- (i) the shooting of wild birds on Electricity or CYTA cables is prohibited.

SCHEDULE

All those areas of Episkopi, Sotira and Paramali villages in so far as they lie within the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area, excluding any Game Reserves published in the Gazette and marked on the ground by appropriate sign-posts.

THE CORONERS ORDINANCE

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 3(2)

THE LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE

(Cap. 226 - Laws of Cyprus - and Ordinances 12 of 1963, 9 of 1964, 1 of 1986, 4 of 1987, 19 of 1988 and 10 of 1993).

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas by Public Instrument No. 56 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette No. 1140 of the 29th December 1998, the Administrator declared the construction of public roads outside the affected area of the Agricultural Land Consolidation area in the villages of Ypsonas and Kolossi in the Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri, to be an undertaking of public utility;

And whereas the Area Officer Akrotiri in compliance with subsection (1) of section 6 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance and by Public Instrument No. 5 of 1999 gave particulars of the land to be acquired in connection with the said undertaking of public utility (hereinafter referred to as "the land");

And whereas the Area Officer Akrotiri, in compliance with subsection (2) of the said section forwarded to the Administrator the required recommendations plan and particulars together with a report that no objections have been made;

And whereas the Administrator has approved the plan and particulars submitted and has considered it expedient, having regard to the circumstances of the case, that the land be acquired.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, the Administrator hereby sanctions the acquisition of the land under the provisions of the said Ordinance.
