THE PETROLEUM ORDINANCE
(Ordinance 1 of 1976)

**ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR
UNDER SECTION 6**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 6 of the Petroleum Ordinance 1976 (hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance"), the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be referred to as the Petroleum (Certain Inflammable Substances other than Petroleum) Order 2003.

2. The Ordinance and any Regulations made thereunder shall apply to the inflammable substances referred to in the Schedule to this Order as if such substances were Petroleum within the meaning of the Ordinance.

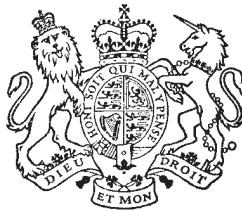
