**THE PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT OF GAME AND  
WILD BIRDS ORDINANCE 2004.**

(Ordinance 15 of 2004)

**ORDER UNDER SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 50**

---

In exercise of the powers vested in me by subsection (2) of section 50 of the Protection and Management of Game and Wild Birds Ordinance 2004 and subject to the provisions of subsection (1) of section 50 of the same Ordinance, I hereby authorise the use by any person, whilst lawfully hunting within the Sovereign Base Areas, of any form of shotgun cartridge, loaded in the usual way with felt or plastic wadding and with shot of permitted sizes, other than cartridges of any trade name or origin, loaded with the use of two plastic wads commonly known as plastic wads or power pistons, the second of which is inversely placed in the cartridge on top of the shot, the effective range of which is stated by the manufacturer or importer to be much longer than that of common cartridges.
