**CUSTOMS (WAREHOUSING FEES) ORDER 2009**

---

The Administrator makes the following Order in exercise of the powers under section 61 of the Customs Ordinance 2005(a).

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Warehousing Fees) Order 2009 and comes into force on the day it is published in the Gazette.

**Warehousing fees**

2. (1) Subject to subsection (2), fees are payable by the importer of goods for each day or part of a day that goods are in the custody of the Administration as follows-

- (a) For each parcel weighing less than 1000 kilograms - €0.34 per 100 kilograms or part thereof
- (b) For each parcel weighing 1000 kilograms or greater - €3.40
- (c) For goods not packed in parcels - €0.17 per 100 kilograms or part thereof
- (d) For goods returned after being held as liable to forfeiture:
  - (i) if the goods weigh less than 1000 kilograms - €0.42
  - (ii) if the goods weigh 1000 kilograms or greater - €0.85.

(2) Fees are not payable in respect of the day that goods cease to be in the custody of the Administration.
