**DOGS (REGISTRATION FEES) (AMENDMENT) NOTICE 2009**

The Chief Officer issues the following Notice in exercise of the powers under section 8(3) of the Dogs Ordinance 2006(a).

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Notice may be cited as the Dogs (Registration Fees) (Amendment) Notice 2009 and comes into force on the day that it is published in the Gazette.

**Amendment of Public Instrument No. 13/2005**

2. Paragraph 4 of the Notice under section 9(b) of the Dogs Ordinance 2004(c) is revoked.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This note is not part of the Notice)**

1. This explanatory note relates to the Dogs (Registration Fees) (Amendment) Notice 2009 (“the Notice”). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Notice. It does not form part of the Notice.
2. The Notice provides for the revocation of the provision in a 2004 Notice that set the fee for the issue of a dog registration certificate at £5 (€8). As a consequence, there is now no fee for registering a dog. The Republic of Cyprus abolished its dog registration fee in April this year in public instrument 158/2009.
