LAND ACQUISITION (SANCTION OF ACQUISITION) (XYLOTYMBOU-ORMIDHIA ROAD) NOTIFICATION 2011

In exercise of the powers under section 7 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance(a), the Administrator, having approved the plan and particulars submitted to him under section 6 of that Ordinance and considering it expedient, having had regard to all of the circumstances of the case and considering that the land referred to in article 2 should be acquired, makes the following notification:

Citation and commencement

1. This notification may be cited as the Land Acquisition (Sanction of Acquisition) (Xylymbou-Ormidhia Road) Notification 2011 and comes into force on 10 October 2011.

Sanction of acquisition

2. (1) The acquisition of the private land specified in paragraph (2) is sanctioned for the upgrading of the Xylymbou-Ormidhia road in the Dhekelia Sovereign Base Area.

(2) The specified land is the private immovable property within the Dhekelia Sovereign Base Area, in the village of Ormidhia, Larnaka District, amounting to approximately 604 square metres being part of plot No 58 on the Government of the Republic Survey Plan 41/13E1 (the “plan”) which is shown coloured red on a copy of the plan signed by the Area Officer Dhekelia dated 25 July 2011 and available for inspection at the Area Office Dhekelia during normal office hours.
