SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION

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ANTIQUITIES (DECLARATION) ORDER 2011

The Chief Officer has given notice in the Antiquities (Proposed Declaration) Notice 2011(a) of a proposal by the Administrator to declare the sites listed in Schedules 1 and 2 of this Order to be ancient monuments in accordance with section 6(1)(a) of the Antiquities Ordinance 1975(b):

The Administrator, having consulted the appropriate authorities of the Republic and having received no objections to the proposal makes the following Order in exercise of the powers under section 6(1)(a) of the Antiquities Ordinance 1975.

Citation commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Antiquities (Declaration) Order 2011 and comes into force on 23 December 2011.

(2) In this Order, the “Ordinance” means the Antiquities Ordinance 1975.

Declaration of ancient monuments

2. (1) The sites listed in Schedule 1 are ancient monuments and are added to Part 2 of Schedule 1 to the Ordinance.

(2) The sites listed in Schedule 2 are ancient monuments and are added to Schedule 2 to the Ordinance.

(3) The sites listed in Schedule 1 and 2 are shown coloured red on 7 plans marked as specified in the relevant Schedule and are stamped by the Lands & Surveys Department of the Republic and dated 27 May 2011 and available for inspection at the Area Office Akrotiri during normal working hours.

Schedule 1

Sites added to Part 2 of Schedule 1 to the Antiquities Ordinance 1975

(Article 2(1))

1. The remains of a late Roman/early Christian settlement at the site of Shiliastasia shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/A (Sheet LIX, Plan 49, Plot 1);
2. The remains of a late Roman/early Christian settlement at the site of Arkosikia shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/A (Sheet LIX, Plan 49, Plot 1);
3. The remains of a late Roman/early Christian settlement at the site of Agios Markos shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/B (Sheet LVIII, Plan 55, Plot 1);
4. The remains of the early Christian basilica of Agia Iphigenia at the site of Agia Phinia shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/C (Sheet LVIII, Plan 62, Plot 2);
5. The remains of a Roman structure at the site of Vromonera 2 shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/D (Sheet LIX, Plan 41, Plot 2); and
6. The medieval bridge close to the Akrotiri Salt Lake shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/E (Sheet LVIII, Plan 30, Plot 33).

Schedule 2

Sites added to Schedule 2 to the Antiquities Ordinance 1975

(Article 2(2))

7. The remains of the medieval channel named Ktista at the site Lishina (Sheet LIX, Plan 33, Plot 9); and
8. The remains of an Archaic sanctuary at the site Anthropos (Sheet LVIII, Plan 48, Plot 14).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the Order)

1. This explanatory note relates to the Antiquities (Declaration) Order 2011 (the “Order”). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Order. It does not form part of the Order.
2. The note should be read in conjunction with the Order. It is not, and is not meant to be, a comprehensive description of the Order. So when a part of the Order does not seem to require any explanation or comment, none is given.
3. The Order is made under section 6(1)(a) of the Antiquities Ordinance 1975 (the “Ordinance”).
4. An order may be made under section 6(1) of the Ordinance declaring any site (or objects or buildings) of historic, architectural, traditional, artistic or archaeological interest to be an ancient monument. If an Order is made under section 6, the site in question becomes an ancient monument and is then subject to certain protections. For example section 10 of the Ordinance makes it an offence to destroy injure or deface an ancient monument.
5. An order under section 6(1) can be made in relation to sites owned by the Republic (by adding the site to Part 1 of Schedule 1), the Crown (by adding the site to Part 2 of Schedule 1) or by any other person (by adding the site to Schedule 2).
6. The Order lists 6 sites which are added to Part 1 of Schedule 1 of the Ordinance and 2 sites which it is proposed are added to Schedule 2 of the Ordinance.
7. Items 1 to 5 in Schedule 1 of the Order are on forest land vested in the Crown within RAF Akrotiri. Item 6 of Schedule 1 to the Order is within the boundaries of a public road vested in the Crown. Items 1 and 2 of Schedule 2 of to the Order are on private property owned by the Bishop of Kition and Bishop of Limassol respectively.

**MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC (MOTORWAY AND SPEED LIMITS)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2011**

The Chief Officer makes the following Order in exercise of his powers under section 4(3) and 4(8) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006(a).

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Motorway and Speed Limits) (Amendment) Order 2011.

(2) In this Order the “principal Order” means the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Motorway and Speed Limits) Order 2008(b).

(3) This Order comes into force on 20 December 2011.

Amendment to the principal Order

2. (1) Schedule 2 (Designation of built up areas) to the principal Order is amended by omitting paragraphs 6 and 7 and substituting them with—

“6. Episkopi Station. The area inside the perimeter fence of Episkopi Station.

7. RAF Akrotiri. The area inside the perimeter fence of RAF Akrotiri”

(2) Paragraph 2(5) of Schedule 3 (Speed limits fixed for roads in built up areas) to the principal Order is amended by omitting “Whirling” and substituting it with “Whirlwind”.

(3) Schedule 5 (Speed limits fixed for other roads) to the principal Order is amended by—

(a) omitting paragraph 1(2)(a); and

(b) inserting the following new sub-paragraph after paragraph 2(10)—

“(11) M1 road between Queen’s Bridge (grid reference 923351) and the East M1 junction (grid reference 944349)”.

Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Motorway and Speed Limits) (Amendment)(No. 2) Order 2009 revoked

3. The Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Motorway and Speed Limits) (Amendment)(No. 2) Order 2009(c) is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the Order)

1. This explanatory note relates to the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Motorway and Speed Limits) (Amendment) Order 2011. It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Order. It does not form part of the Order.
2. The note should be read in conjunction with the Order. It is not, and is not meant to be, a comprehensive description of the Order. So when a provision does not seem to require any explanation or comment, none is given.
3. The Order amends the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Motorway and Speed Limits) Order 2008 (the “principal Order”) by correcting some typographical errors in Schedules 2 and 3.
4. The Order also amends the principal Order by amending the maximum speed limit for
 - a stretch of road on the Kolossi to Akrotiri Road between the Aeroporos Horse Stables and the strawberry kiosk. The speed limit is reduced from 80 kilometres per hour to 65 kilometres per hour; and
 - part of the M1 road. The speed limit between Queen’s Bridge and the East M1 junction is reduced from 80 kilometres per hour (specified in section 4(2)(c) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006) to 50 kilometres per hour. It is expected that this reduction in the speed limit will be temporary pending improvements to the road surface.
