**CONTROL (PROHIBITION OF ENTRY) ORDER 2012**

---

The Administrator makes the following Order in exercise of the powers in section 6 of the Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) Ordinance 1960(a).

**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the Control (Prohibition of Entry) Order 2012.

**Commencement**

2. This Order comes into force on publication in the Gazette.

**Prohibition of entry into Areas, etc**

3. The persons named in the Schedule are prohibited from entering the Areas and from continuing to be present in the Areas.
