
POLICE AND PRISON OFFICERS (PENSIONS)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2015

The Chief Constable and Superintendent of Prisons, with the approval of the Administrator, makes the following regulations in exercise of powers in section 15(2) of the Prisons Ordinance 1971(a) and section 9 of the Police Ordinance 2007(b).

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police and Prison Officers (Pensions) (Amendment) Regulations 2015.

Commencement

2. These Regulations come into force on 1 January 2016.

Amendment to Police and Prison Officers (Pensions) Regulations 2009

3. The Police and Prison Officers (Pensions) Regulations 2009(c) are amended as follows.

Substitution of regulation 3

4. For regulation 3 (application) substitute—

“3. These Regulations apply to an officer who—

(a) was recruited on the island of Cyprus; and

(b) commenced service in the combined service before 1 January 2016.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

1. This explanatory note relates to the Police and Prison Officers (Pensions) (Amendment) Regulations 2015 (the “Regulations”). It has been prepared by the office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Regulations. It does not form part of the Regulations.

2. The Regulations amend the Police and Prison Officers (Pensions) Regulations 2009 to provide that they apply only to locally engaged police officers who commenced service before 1 January 2016.
