
**OFFENDERS REMOVAL AND DETENTION
ORDINANCE (COMMENCEMENT) ORDER 2016**

The Chief Officer makes the following Order in exercise of the powers under section 2(2) of the Offenders Removal and Detention Ordinance 2016(a).

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Offenders Removal and Detention Ordinance (Commencement) Order 2016.

(2) It comes into force on 10 November 2016.

Coming into force of the Offenders Removal and Detention Ordinance 2016

2. The remaining provisions(b) of the Offenders Removal and Detention Ordinance 2016 come into force on 10 November 2016.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

1. This explanatory note relates to the Offenders Removal and Detention Ordinance (Commencement) Order 2016 (the “Order”). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Order. It does not form part of the Order.
2. The Order provides that, with the exception of section 34, the Offenders Removal and Detention Ordinance 2016 (“the Ordinance”) will come into force on 10 November 2016. Section 34 is already in force, having come into force when the Ordinance was made.
