THE QUARANTINE LAW. CAP. 145.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2832

MADE UNDER SECTIONS 6 AND 8.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 6 and 8 of the Cap. 145 Quarantine Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following Regulations :---

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Quarantine (Maritime and Aerial) (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Quarantine (Maritime and Aerial) Regulations, 1953 and 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Quarantine (Maritime and Aerial) Regulations, 1953 to 1956.

2. The Tenth Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "N.B.—On Sundays and public holidays the charges would be one and a half times those set out above", occurring at the end of the first paragraph thereof, and the substitution therefor of the following :—

"The above charges shall be increased by 50 per centum when overtime work is required to be performed before 8.00 a.m. or after 4.00 p.m. on any Sunday or other day appointed by the Governor to be a day when Customs Houses are closed for business.".

THE ALIENS AND IMMIGRATION LAW, 1952.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 20.

13 of 1952.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 20 of the Aliens and Immigration Law, 1952, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Aliens and Immigration (Registration of Aliens) (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Aliens and Immigration (Registration of Aliens) Regulations (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after Regulation 6, of the following regulation :----

"6A. Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations a registration officer may at any time call upon any alien resident within his district to furnish such registration officer with three copies of a photograph representing a true likeness of himself not larger than two inches wide by three inches long.".

THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force in consequence of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1955), His Excellency the Governor by this Order, orders as follows :—

1. Subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the First Schedule to this Order, the use, for military purposes, of the land and property specified in the Second Schedule (hereinafter referred to as "the land") during the period of six months from the date of this Order is hereby authorized.

2. The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for such military purposes.

3. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

I. The land shall be occupied and used for military purposes only.

2. At the expiration of this Order the land shall be restored to the persons entitled thereto free of any erection, structure or construction erected or constructed thereon after the making of this Order.

3. Compensation shall be paid to the persons having an interest on the land for its use and occupation under this Order.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

All those privately owned properties situated in Ayia Paraskevi Quarter of the village of Lapithos, comprising land, buildings and all appurtenances thereto under plots Nos. 612, 613, 614, 615, 616, 617, 618, 761/1, 761/2 and 764/3 of the Government Survey Plan of Lapithos village and plots Nos. 196 and 197/1 of the Government Survey Plan No. XI.23, more particularly defined as the areas coloured red on the plan signed by the Assistant Director of Hirings, Cyprus, dated the 21st April, 1956, and deposited in the Commissioner's Office, Kyrenia.

LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

Order made under Section 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 618 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th October, 1955, 1 do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Larnaca District No. 5) Order, 1956.

2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Larnaca, or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 28th day of April, 1956.

Order made under Section 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 618 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th October, 1955, I do hereby order as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Larnaca District No. 6) Order, 1956.

2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Larnaca or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 30th day of April, 1956.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

The area of the town of Larnaca within the following boundaries :---

Commencing at the junction of Stadium Street and Nikiphoros Phokas Street; along Nikiphoros Phokas Street and Dhigheni Akrita Street; along Ermou Street to its junction with D. N. Demetriou Street. Thence along D. N. Demetriou Street to its junction with Zinonos Kiticos Street; along Zinonos Kiticos Street to its junction with Ermou Street. Thence through the Municipal Market and Aristoteles Street to St. Lazaros Street; along St. Lazaros Street to its junction with Ayias Phaneromenis Street; thence along Ayias Phaneromenis Street to its junction with Adhonidhos Street. Provided that hotels may remain open for the purposes of catering for residents staying therein.
