ORDINANCE 7 OF 1961.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE COURTS ORDINANCE

WILLIAM MACDONALD,

ADMINISTRATOR.

Be it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Courts (Amendment) Ordinance, 1961, and shall be read as one with the Courts Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Ordinance").
2. The principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after Section 10 thereof the following new section, to be numbered 10A:-

"10A—(1) Any Senior Judge may, in any proceedings in the Judge's Court, exercise the powers of a Judge, but in such case shall be precluded from exercising the powers of a Senior Judge in any proceedings in the Senior Judge's Court in which such proceedings of the Judge's Court are called in question.

(2) In deciding whether a Senior Judge is precluded from taking part in the proceedings of the Senior Judge's Court by reason of the operation of this section, the ruling of the Court shall be final."
