ORDINANCE 3 OF 1963.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE FIREARMS ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963, and shall be read as one with the Firearms Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

2. Section 7 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting in the last line of sub-section (4) thereof the word "shall" and substituting therefor the word "may".

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Workmen's Compensation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963, and shall be read as one with the Workmen's Compensation Ordinance, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

2. Section 10 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after sub-section (1) thereof the following four new sub-sections, to be numbered sub-sections (2), (3), (4) and (5) respectively:—

"(2) In fixing the amount of the periodical payment the Court shall have regard to any payment, allowance or benefit which the workman may receive from the employer during the incapacity.

(3) On the ceasing of the incapacity before the date, on which any periodical payment falls due, there shall be payable in respect of that period a sum proportionate to the duration of the incapacity in that period.

(4) Where a workman in receipt of periodical payments under the provisions of this section intends to leave the neighbourhood in which he was employed, for the purpose of residing elsewhere, he shall give notice of such intention to the employer who may agree with the workman for the redemption of such periodical payments by a lump sum, or for the continuance of such periodical payments. If the employer and workman are unable to agree either party may apply to the Court which shall have jurisdiction to order such redemption and to determine the amount to be paid or to order the continuance of the periodical payments:

Provided that any lump sum so ordered to be paid together with the periodical payments already made to the workman shall not exceed the lump sum which would be payable in respect of the same degree of incapacity under the provisions of section 8 or 9, as the case may be, if the incapacity were permanent.

(5) If a workman in receipt of periodical payments under the provisions of this section leaves the neighbourhood in which he was employed, for the purpose of residing elsewhere, without giving notice as provided in sub-section (4), or having given such notice leaves the neighbourhood as aforesaid without having come to an agreement with his employer for the redemption or continuance of such periodical payments, or without having made an application to the Court under the provisions of sub-section (4), he shall not be entitled to any benefits under this Ordinance during or in respect of the period of his absence. If the period of such absence shall exceed six months, the workman shall cease to be entitled to any benefits under this Ordinance."

ORDINANCE 5 OF 1963.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE COURTS ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Courts (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963, and shall be read as one with the Courts Ordinance, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

Short title

Ordinances 3 of 1960, 7 of 1961, 19 of 1962.

2. The principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after Section 12 thereof the following new section, to be numbered 12A:—

New Section 12A added to principal Ordinance.

"Appointment of Assistant Registrar.

12A. (1) The Administrator may appoint any person to be Assistant Registrar of both the Senior Judge's Court and the Judge's Court who shall perform such duties of the Registrar as

he may be required to perform by the Senior Judge, Judge or Registrar as the case may be.

(2) Any person appointed to be Assistant Registrar under sub-section (1) of this section shall be Deputy Sheriff of each of the said Courts and shall discharge his duties as such under the direction of the Sheriff.

(3) The Deputy Sheriff shall enjoy the same immunities as the Sheriff as are set out in the proviso to Section 15 of this Ordinance.”
