ORDINANCE 1 OF 1966.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Ordinance 1966 and shall be read as one with the Criminal Procedure Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

Short title.

Cap. 155 (Laws of Cyprus) and Ordinances 4 of 1960 and 19 of 1963.

2. Section 17 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately thereafter the following two new subsections to be numbered (2) and (3) respectively:-

Section 17 of the principal Ordinance amended.

"(2) Where a person would otherwise be required to execute a bond, or enter into a recognisance, with sureties, under the provisions of paragraph (a) or (b) of subsection (1) of this Section, such person may, in lieu of executing such bond or entering into such recognisance, deposit with the officer in charge of the police station a sum of money of such amount as the said officer may fix.

(3) The Fiscal Officer shall give such directions as appear to him to be necessary to provide for the accounting for and the custody and control of sums of money deposited with police officers under the provisions of subsection (2) of this Section.”.

ORDINANCE 2 OF 1966

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE OLIVE OIL ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:-

Short title.
Ordinance
18 of 1966.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Olive Oil (Amendment) Ordinance, 1966, and shall be read as one with the Olive Oil Ordinance, 1963 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”).

Section 6 of
the principal
Ordinance
amended.

2. Section 6 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding immediately after paragraph (c) in subsection (1) thereof the following new paragraph to be lettered (d):

“(d) any other oil which does not contain olive oil, as edible oil, unless a clear and legible description is given on the containers in which such oil is offered for sale describing the kind of oil contained therein according to the fruit or seed from which it is extracted.”.
