ORDINANCE 4 OF 1966.

AN ORDINANCE

**TO AMEND THE MOTOR VEHICLES
AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE.**

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance, 1966 and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

2. Section 7 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after subsection (2) thereof the following new subsection to be numbered (3):-

"(3) For the purpose of this section the expression "special reasons" shall mean reasons which are, in the opinion of the Court trying the offence, special to the offence or to the offender."

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1966 and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

2. Section 3 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after subsection (3) thereof the following new subsection to be numbered (3A):-
