**ORDINANCE 1 OF 1969.**

**AN ORDINANCE**

TO CONTINUE TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE RECOGNITION IN THE SOVEREIGN BASE AREAS OF AKROTIRI AND DHEKELIA OF CERTAIN LICENCES, CERTIFICATES, RECEIPTS AND OTHER OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS OF AUTHORITY OR PERMISSION ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITIES OF THE REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS AND TO CONSOLIDATE AND EXTEND LEGISLATION ENACTED FOR THE SAME PURPOSE.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Recognition of Republican Licences Ordinance, 1969.

Short title.

2. In this Ordinance the expression "equivalent Ordinances of the Areas", when used in relation to the expression "Republican Law", means an Ordinance dealing with the same matters or things as are dealt with by such Republican Law.

Interpretation.

Schedule.

3.—(1) The licences, certificates of registration, receipts and other documents of authority or permission set out in the second column of the Schedule hereto being issued or effected in the Republic under the provisions of the Republican Laws set out in the first column of the Schedule, shall, in respect of the persons set out in the third column of the said Schedule and for the purposes or under conditions set out in the fourth column of the said Schedule, be recognised in the Areas as if they had been issued and effected under the comparable provisions of equivalent Ordinances of the Areas.

(2) The Administrator may by notice published in the Gazette add to, delete from or amend the Schedule.

4. The Recognition of Republican Licences Ordinance, 1961, is hereby repealed.

## AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE JUVENILE OFFENDERS ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Juvenile Offenders (Amendment) Ordinance, 1969, and shall be read as one with the Juvenile Offenders Ordinance, as amended by the Juvenile Offenders (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

Cap. 157 (Laws of Cyprus) Ordinance No. 3 of 1962.

Section 4A of the principal Ordinance amended.

2. Section 4A of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended:-

(i) by deleting in the first and second lines of subsection (2) thereof the words and brackets "(at least one of whom shall be a woman)" and substituting therefor the following words and brackets:-

"(at least one of whom, unless the Judge in exceptional or unavoidable circumstances otherwise directs, shall be a woman)";

(ii) by deleting in subsection (5) thereof the word "murder" and substituting therefor the words "premeditated murder or homicide"; and

(iii) by inserting immediately after subsection (5) thereof of the following new subsection to be numbered 6:-

"(6) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the Judge may, at any time, in special circumstances by certificate or pronouncement in Court dispense with the aid or continued aid of either or both assessors."
