ORDINANCE 5 OF 1971.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE CONTROL (ENTRY, SETTLEMENT
AND COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISES) ORDINANCE, 1960.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1971 and shall be read as one with the Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Ordinance").

2. The principal Ordinance is hereby amended by repealing Section 20 thereof and substituting therefor the following new section :

Section 20 of

"Restriction
on residence
in the Areas.

20.—(1) Subject to provisions of this section, no person shall reside in the Areas for more than twenty eight days in any consecutive period of twelve months, save in accordance with a permit in writing issued by a Control Officer and subject to any conditions attached hereto.

(2) This section shall not apply :

(a) to a recognised resident described in categories (d) and (e) of the definition of

"recognised resident" in Section 2 of this Ordinance or to a person described in category (a) of the said definition who is not also a person described in category (f) of the said definition ;

- (b) to a recognised resident described in categories (b), (c) and (f) of the said definition, for so long as such persons are residing in any premises approved by the Administrator for their residence or temporary sojourn.

ORDINANCE 6 OF 1971.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE WELLS ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows :

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Wells (Amendment) Ordinance, 1971 and shall be read as one with the Wells Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

Short title.

Cap. 351 (Laws of Cyprus).

2. Section 6 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after subsection (8) thereof the following new subsection to be numbered (8A) :—

Section 6 of the principal Ordinance amended.

"(8A) Where a summons has been issued in respect of an offence under this section, the Area Officer or any person, including any police officer, acting on his behalf may make application to the Judge's Court for an order that any operations proceeding in respect of any drilling, sinking or construction of a well or deepening or enlarging of an existing well, alleged in the charge pertaining to the offence to be so proceeding in contravention of the provisions of this section be suspended or discontinued pending hearing of the charge and the Court shall make such order thereon as it deems appropriate :

Provided that such order shall be made subject to the provisions of the Civil Procedure Ordinance, the Civil Procedure Rules and the Courts Ordinance, 1960."

3. Section 13 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended:—

(a) by inserting immediately after the figure "3" in the second line of subsection (1) thereof a comma and the figure "5" ;

Section 13 of the principal Ordinance amended.

- (b) by inserting immediately after the figure "3" in the fourth line of subsection (1) thereof the following words and brackets: "(read with Section 5 where appropriate)";
- (c) by deleting the words and figure "in contravention of section 3" in the fifth line of subsection (1) thereof and substituting therefor the words and figures:

"or widened, deepened or otherwise extended in contravention of Section 3 or 5".

Section 15 of the principal Ordinance amended.

4. Section 15 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended:—

- (a) by inserting immediately after the word "repair" in the first line thereof the words "or cleaning"; and
- (b) by deleting the full stop at the end of the said section, substituting a colon therefor and inserting immediately after the following new proviso:—

"Provided further that the person proposing to carry out such operation of repairing, cleaning, sinking or constructing a well shall give the Area Officer, at least forty-eight hours before the commencement of such operation, a notice in writing of his intention to carry out such operation and by such notice shall fix the date of commencement of such operation. Any person giving a notice as above shall be deemed to have consented to an entry under sub-section (1) of Section 16 of this Ordinance for a period commencing at the date on which the notice was received and ending on the day after the date fixed as above as the date of commencement of such operation."

New Section 16 added to the principal Ordinance.

5. The principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 15 thereof the following new section to be numbered 16:—

"Power of entry.

16.—(1) An Area Officer, any officer acting under his written instructions (hereinafter referred to in this section as "an authorised officer") or any police officer, with the consent of the occupier, or under an order of the Judge's Court, shall have power, at reasonable times, to enter upon any land where a well site or well or water or water pumping installation exists in order to make enquiries or to take measurements in connection with the pumping of water.

(2) Any person who wilfully obstructs an Area Officer, an authorised officer or a police officer in the exercise of his power under this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds or to both such imprisonment and fine."
