ORDINANCE 1 OF 1972.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE CORONERS ORDINANCE.

ADMINISTRATOR

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Coroners (Amendment) Ordinance, 1972 and shall be read as one with the Coroners Ordinance, as amended from time to time, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

Short title.

Cap. 153 (Laws of Cyprus), Ordinances 7 of 1964, 11 of 1967.

2. The principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 4 thereof the following new section to be numbered 4A:

New Section 4A added to the principal Ordinance.

"Special provision in relation to deaths occurring or caused outside Cyprus.

4A. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Ordinance or of any other Ordinance, or any provision of common law or custom relating to the practice of Coroners, a Coroner shall not be bound to hold an inquest or do anything which may otherwise have to be done under the provisions of this Ordinance in respect of the body of a deceased person which is lying within the Areas, if the Coroner is satisfied:—

(a) that such person has died outside the Island of Cyprus: or

- (b) that the cause of the death of such person has solely occurred outside the Island of Cyprus ; and, in either case,
 - (c) (i) that an appropriate civil or military authority has already decided that no inquest or other enquiry is necessary in respect of such death ; or
 - (ii) that an appropriate civil or military authority has held or is expected to hold an adequate enquiry into the cause of the death.”.

ORDINANCE 2 OF 1972.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Ordinance, 1972, and shall be read as one with the Criminal Procedure Ordinance, as amended from time to time, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance").

Short title.

Cap. 155 (Laws of Cyprus), Ordinances 4 of 1960, 19 of 1963 and 1 of 1966.

2. Section 45 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting in the second line of paragraph (b) of the proviso to subsection (1) thereof, the words "a mukhtar" and substituting therefor the following:—

Section 45 of the principal Ordinance amended.

"a Registrar, or a mukhtar of the Areas or the Republic (by whatever name commonly called), or duly certified by an advocate, or by any other responsible person (other than a police officer) whose certification is acceptable to the Court".
