ORDINANCE 5 OF 1975.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE ADVOCATES ORDINANCE.

ACTING ADMINISTRATOR

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Advocates (Amendment) Ordinance, 1975 and shall be read as one with the Advocates Ordinance, 1962 as amended by the Advocates (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”).

2. The principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after Section 5 thereof the following new Section to be numbered 5A:—

“Special provisions for the United Nations Organisation in Cyprus.

5A.—(1) Any court of the Areas may admit to practise in any specified proceedings any person who satisfies the Court:—

- (a) that he is employed by the United Nations Organisation, or is a member of a military force and is serving under the command of the Military Commander of the United Nations Force in Cyprus, or is a member of a contingent of the United Nations Force in Cyprus; and
- (b) that he is professionally qualified, under the law of, or accepted practice in, any country, to appear as an advocate or to hold a judicial appointment (by whichever names called) in that country; and

(c) that he is appearing without fee with the authority of the Military Commander of the United Nations Force in Cyprus on behalf of a person who currently is, or at any time relevant to the specified proceedings was, a member of a military force serving under the command of the said Military Commander or a member of a contingent of the said United Nations Force.

(2) Part IV of this Ordinance shall not apply to a person who is permitted to practise under the provisions of this Section.”
