ORDINANCE 7 OF 1975.

**AN ORDINANCE**

TO AMEND THE POLICE ORDINANCE, 1967.

ADMINISTRATOR

**BE** it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Ordinance, 1975 and shall be read as one with the Police Ordinance, 1967 as amended by the Police (Amendment) Ordinance, 1969 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”).

2. Section 9 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting in sub-section (2) thereof, immediately after paragraph (k), the following new paragraph to be lettered (kk) :

“(kk) payment and withholding of pensions;”.

3. Section 13 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding immediately after subsection (3) thereof the following new subsection to be numbered (4) :—

“(4) Nothing in this section shall apply to a police officer, or widow, or member of the family of a deceased police officer if in the opinion of the Administrator, which shall be final, the said officer, widow, or family would receive equal or better treatment under the provisions of regulations made under paragraph (kk) of section 9 of this Ordinance than

would have been received by such officer, widow, or family under the provisions of this section or any regulations made thereunder.”.

4.—(1) For the avoidance of doubt regulations made under the provisions of Section 9 of the principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance shall be treated as “regulations” referred to in sub-section (2) of section 11 of the Prisons Ordinance, 1971.

(2) The first reference in the first column of the Second Schedule to the Prisons Ordinance, 1971 is hereby deleted and the following reference substituted therefor :—

“Section 13 (1), (2) and (4)”.
