ORDINANCE 1 OF 1982.

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1982 and shall be read as one with the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”).

Short title.

Ordinance 11/74.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Ordinance is hereby amended:

First Schedule to the principal Ordinance amended.

(a) by deleting the figure “£ 15.000 mils” appearing in Form B1 (First Game Licence—Shot Gun) thereto and substituting therefor the figure “£ 20.000 mils”; and

(b) by deleting the figure “£ 5.000 mils” appearing in Form B2 (Game Licence Other Than a Licence Issued For the First Time—Shot Gun) thereto and substituting therefor the figure “£ 10.000 mils”.

3. The Second Schedule to the principal Ordinance is hereby amended:

Second Schedule to the principal Ordinance amended.

(a) by deleting the amount of “£ 15” appearing in Column 4 (“fee payable”) thereto and substituting therefor the amount of “£ 20”; and

- (b) by deleting the amount of "£5" appearing in Column 4 ("fee payable") thereto and substituting therefor the amount of "£10".

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Gazette, with the exception of paragraph (b) of Section 2 of this Ordinance and paragraph (b) of Section 3 of this Ordinance, which shall come into operation on 1st August, 1982.
